ENTRY DEADLINE: 3/1/2018

Eligibility & Entry Requirements

- Artist must be a high school junior or senior residing in the *Greater Conejo Valley* or attending a *Greater Conejo Valley* school.
- Work accepted into a prior WVAG Student Awards Show(s) is **ineligible**.
- Maximum of 2 (two) entries per artist.
- **All work must be original and created by the submitting artist.**
- **Source materials, including photographs, must be the artist's own.**
- Completed Entry Form and digital image of each entry must be sent on or before Saturday, March 1, 2018.

This is a JURIED SHOW and only the strongest entries, as determined by the Jury, will be invited to exhibit and compete for prizes.

Notification of Acceptance Status

Applicants will be notified on **March 15, 2018** which, if any, of their entries have been accepted by the Jury. Upon notification of acceptance, applicant should prepare work for take-in (see Accepted Entry Requirements below) and have the work ready for take-in on date/time to be announced.

Accepted Entry Requirements

Additional requirements for entries Juried into the Show

- Hanging straps on back of artwork
- Professionally Finished (appropriate framing or *standard* Gallery Wrapped).
- Maximum of 30" x 40" or 30 pounds.
- Securely attached I.D. tag on back of art with student's name, school, teacher, telephone number, E-Mail address and title of work.
- **No copies or reproductions accepted.**
